STARINE (FR) broke inward bumping with OWSLEY at the start, settled in good position along the backstretch, rapidly closed the gap while three wide on the turn, charged to the front in upper stretch, extended her lead inside the furlong marker then held off BANKS HILL under steady right hand encouragement. BANKS HILL (GB) was rated just off the early pace, raced just behind the winner to the turn, launched a rally four wide entering the stretch then finished well from outside to hold the place. ISLINGTON (IRE) broke slowly, steadied repeatedly in the early stages, moved between horses on the first turn, raced well back for six furlongs, swung four wide for clear sailing on the turn then finished strongly to narrowly miss the place. GOLDEN APPLES (IRE) steadied sharply in the early stages, was outrun for seven furlongs, circled six wide while launching her move on the turn then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. GOSSAMER (GB) saved ground while working her way forward on the turn, angled between horses at the top of the stretch, made a run to reach contention in mid stretch then improved her position with a mild late rally. KAZZIA (GER) sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace along the rail into upper stretch then faltered. RISKVERSE was outrun for a mile while saving ground, rallied along the inside in upper stretch, checked in traffic inside the furlong marker and failed to threaten thereafter. ZENDA (GB) broke in the air at the start, steadied sharply in the early stages, closed the gap between horses on the turn, steadied in traffic in mid stretch then failed to menace thereafter. TURTLE BOW (FR) saved ground while just off the pace into upper stretch then checked along the rail while tiring in the final eighth. DUBLINO steadied in traffic in the early stages then failed to threaten while racing wide. CHOPININA chased the early leader from outside, lodged a mild bid on the turn then faltered. OWSLEY was never a factor after being bumped at the start.
