ORIENTATE broke inward at the start, stalked four wide along the backstretch, edged closer on the turn, gradually gained inside the furlong marker then wore down THUNDERELLO in the final twenty yards. THUNDERELLO dueled early along the inside, shook loose on the turn, maintained a clear advantage into mid stretch, continued on the front into deep stretch then yielded grudgingly. CRAFTY C. T. was unhurried along the backstretch, closed the gap while four wide on the turn then finished willingly to gain a share. KONA GOLD was outrun early after being bumped at the start, rallied six wide leaving the turn, closed the gap to reach contention in mid stretch then flattened out a bit in the final sixteenth. KALOOKAN QUEEN reserved early, rallied along the inside to reach contention in upper stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. XTRA HEAT chased the leaders along the inside to the top of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. DISTURBINGTHEPEACE saved ground to the turn after breaking a bit slowly then lacked a strong closing bid. SWEPT OVERBOARD failed to threaten while wide throughout. TOUCH TONE raced five wide while in the middle of the pack for a half then lacked a further response. BONAPAW was bumped then pinched back at the start and failed to threaten thereafter. DAY TRADER checked slightly at the start, raced within striking distance while four wide for a half then faded in the stretch. WAKE AT NOON was never a factor after being bumped at the start. CARSON HOLLOW dueled for the lead from outside for three furlongs then checked while giving way on the turn.
