CAPE BLANCO (IRE), carried out a bit by PROCEED BEE while being prompted to gain a contending position racing into the straight, raced just off the second flight outside a rival to the backstretch, responded when given his cue entering the far turn to advance to striking distance with a sharp, three wide move, wrested command in upper stretch and held sway on a clear margin to the end under firm prompting. GIO PONTI, held up well off the pace in early stages while angling to the inside, made steady progress inside foes on the second bend, shifted out to race four wide between foes entering upper stretch and prevailed for place honors. DEAN'S KITTEN gained position just off the leaders under rating along the inside racing to the backstretch, continued under reserve saving ground on the second bend, shifted out in upper stretch to challenge, couldn't menace the winner and was outfinished for second. WIGMORE HALL (IRE) broke slowly, was guided to the rail entering the straight in the opening quarter while making some progress to gain a position off the second flight, was pulling his rider along through the backstretch, shifted off the inside nearing the second bend, was shuffled in traffic while in hand approaching the quarter mile marker, shifted out six wide entering upper stretch and made some effort to improve his placing. RAHYSTRADA prompted to a contending position near the inside early, tracked the leaders unhurried between foes while losing some position racing to the far turn, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, came through along the inside entering the lane, then angled out five wide while being roused to challenge nearing midstretch and made some belated progress. TAJAAWEED was settled in hand in the opening stages, shifted off the inside after the opening quarter, switched out nearing the far turn, continued four and five wide to upper stretch and lacked the needed closing bid. MISSION APPROVED was urged to secure the lead while shifting nearer the inside racing into the straight, dictated a measured pace to the far turn, had no response when challenged by the winner and emptied out in the drive. PROCEED BEE shifted out in the opening stages while being prompted to gain a forward placing, stalked just off the pacesetter to the far turn but came up empty midway through the far turn and quickly gave way. ZACK HALL (FR) raced unhurried three wide just off the second flight in the opening stages, made a brief bid between foes in that path racing into the far turn but quickly retreated in upper stretch. GENERAL PERFECT was never a factor.
