STEPHANIE'S KITTEN was well placed between horses, split rivals inside the three-sixteenths pole to commence her bid, found a seam with a furlong to run, quickened once clear, caught STOPSHOPPINGMARIA late and was inching away. The latter set a pressured pace toward the hedge, fought on gamely through a prolonged drive, but was unable to resist the winner. SWEET CAT tracked the pace three wide, moved up to engage the leader after a half, disputed the issue to the final furlong, weakened slightly but had enough left to hold the show. UP (IRE) settled saving ground in mid pack, worked her way to the outside between horses through the upper stretch and was making up ground. HARD NOT TO LIKE settled in hand six wide, made an early move circling the field, loomed large entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. SOMALI LEMONADE fought restraint through the opening half between horses, leveled into stride on the second turn, swung seven wide and improved position. PURE GOSSIP attended the pace four wide, shifted out six wide entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. ELUSIVE KATE settled between horses four wide, was forced out on the backstretch, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. DAYATTHESPA was forwardly placed along the inside, got through entering the stretch but came up empty in the drive. ROYAL BONNIE was close up four wide, but faltered between rivals after six furlongs and faded. CUSTOMER BASE was unhurried into stride, was hung wide throughout and failed to respond. MY GI GI broke in the air to get away slow, settled saving ground but was never a factor. ANN OF THE DANCE raced wide throughout and showed little. DEAR LAVINIA broke slow, was rank to place, pulled between horses, but came up empty on the second turn and retreated.
