MY MISS AURELIA moved up between rivals entering the first turn, tracked the pacesetter CANDREA while under rating, moved to command in hand past the five sixteenths marker, edged clear when roused a quarter mile out, drifted in near the three sixteenths marker, was straightened away soon after, widened a furlong out and held firm under solid right handed pressure. GRACE HALL rated comfortably off the rail, commenced her run leaving the five eighths pole, moved between rivals with three eighths remaining and set her sights on the leaders, angled out four wide entering the stretch then chased the winner home in game fashion. WEEMISSFRANKIE was hung out four wide while in a forward position, angled six wide advancing past the five sixteenths marker, continued willingly but could not make an impact in the drive. SELF PRESERVATION, away in good order to be with the early pace, fought restraint and steadied off the winner's heels entering the first turn, dropped back off the pace mid way down the backstretch, worked between rivals in upper stretch, dropped to the rail and continued on with interest. QUESTING (GB) saved ground, edged closer leaving the five eighths pole, encountered traffic from the half mile pole to the three furlong marker, was maneuvered outward past the five sixteenths marker, made a slight run in upper stretch then flattened out. MISS NETTA was squeezed back soon after the start, saved ground while off the early pace, angled out nearing the far turn, gained ground into the lane then failed to sustain. NORTHERN PASSION, three wide into the first turn, angled in for the backstretch run, altered back out for the drive but failed to menace. PUTTHEBABIESDOWN, between rivals early lacking speed, angled out and circled five wide for the drive, switched to her left lead nearing the eighth pole and came up empty. FROLIC'S REVENGE raced well wide throughout. SAY A NOVENA, four wide stalking the pace, took closer order under a ride leaving the three eighths pole, chased into the lane then gave way. CANDREA, nudged to the front, set the pace inside, was taken on after six furlongs, gave little resistance and faltered in upper stretch. AWESOME BELLE, five wide into the first turn, continued wide chasing the pace and gave way through the lane. ROCKET TWENTYONE saved ground stalking the pace and tired after six furlongs. HOMECOMING QUEEN (IRE) was outrun while removed from the inside.
