1 MILE. (Turf) (1.313) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 FOXWOODS JUST A GAME S. (GRADE I) FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$4,000 to pass the entry box. All starters to receive a \$2,000 rebate. The purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Weights Three-year-olds, 116 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 twice in 2010-11 or a Grade 2 twice on the turf in 2011 allowed 3 lbs.; A Grade 1 in 2010-11 or a Grade 2 in 2011, 5 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, star tier and restricted races not considered in allowances). Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, May 28, 2011 with 28 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the main track.). (Showery 72)

C. S. SILK worked her way to the front soon after the start, was guided over to the two path, showed the way from there, with the rider applying rating tactics and facing some resistance, continued along on the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, spun into the stretch under encouragement, extended her margin during the ensuing furlong, despite drifting off badly, stubbornly resisting the right handed pressure utilized by the jockey to counteract it, maintained a safe margin, eventually crossing the wire, well out in the course. FANTASIA (GB) off to a sluggish start, lagged behind for the initial half, was put to a drive from midway on the turn, came five wide for the stretch run, then closed with good energy down the outside of the course to garner place honors. AMEN HALLELUJAH rode the pocket until the eighth pole, got out finished. JUSTAROUNDMIDNIGHT (IRE) unhurried off the inside for almost six furlongs, was urged from the four path into the lane, advanced willingly until the eighth pole before flattening out a bit. GYPSY'S WARNING (SAF) saved ground and lacked the needed response. AVIATE (GB) well placed, stalking the pacesetter from the outside under a firm hold until the quarter pole, came up empty for the stretch drive. MUCH REJOICING broke in front, readily conceded the advantage to the top one, accompanied that opponent three wide for six furlongs and gave way. STRIKE THE BELL placed five wide at the head of the stretch, offered no response. CHEROKEE QUEEN four wide departing the backstretch had little left after entering the stretch.
