1 $\frac{1}{8}$ MILES. (1.401) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 *REBEL S. (GRADE II) THREE YEAR OLDS.* By subscription of \$200 which shall accompany the nomination, original nominators paying \$2,500 to pass the entry box and \$2,500 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made by the closing time of entries at a fee of \$10,000 which qualifies to start with \$300,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally among all other starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 3 lbs.; \$40,000 at a mile or over anytime 5 lbs.; \$18,000 at any distance 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered.) In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings, excluding money won in restricted races. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Early Bird closing Friday, February 11, 2011 at \$300 for The Southwest, The Rebel and The Arkansas Derby. Nominations closed Friday, March 11, 2011 with 115 nominees. (Cloudy 62)

THE FACTOR broke alertly and soon cleared without encouragement, raced unopposed while rating the middle half mile, stayed clear into the lane, not threatened in the drive, accelerated under intermittent right handed urging. CALEB'S POSSE lacked speed, moved a bit closer toward the inside far turn, moved out to be five wide turning into the lane, no match for the winner, proved determined to hold the place.

ARCHARCHARCH within striking distance along the inside, continued to save ground into the lane, set down, outkicked for the place.

SARATOGA RED chased off the inside, asked into the far turn, chased up the backstretch, had little left for the drive while still salvaging some position down the lane. J W BLUE off a bit slow, void of any kind of early foot, saved ground into the lane, moved out, improved slightly. SWAY

AWAY a bit fractious in the gate, rank, steadied into the first turn, raced outside, managed little in the way of a rally. J P'S GUSTO settled off the pace, moved a bit closer late in the final turn in the three path, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. PICKO'S PRIDE rank, slow to settle

in the first turn, failed to rally. BLUEGRASS JAM four wide into the first turn, did not menace.
