Closed with 16. \$3,750 to pass the entry box and \$7,500 to start with \$750,000 guaranteed, of which \$450,000 to first, \$150,000 to second, \$90,000 to third, \$45,000 to fourth and \$15,000 to fifth. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, breeder, trainer, and jockey. be given to the high weights based upon the weight assignments, adjusted for the sex allowance. Total earnings in 2010-11 will be used in determining the preference of horses with equally assigned weights. No horse shall be assigned more than 126 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, breeder, trainer, and jockey. (Clear 79)

GAME ON DUDE prompted the pace three deep, took a short lead a quarter mile out, fought back off the rail into the stretch, bumped hard twice with TWIRLING CANDY under left handed urging nearing midstretch, drifted inward in the final furlong, fought back under right handed pressure and gamely prevailed. SETSUKO stalked the pace three wide, went up five wide on the second turn, bid outside foes leaving that turn and four wide into the stretch, was bumped hard twice nearing midstretch, drifted in and battled outside the winner to the wire and continued gamely. QUINDICI MAN chased off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and finished well. SOUL CANDY broke in a bit, settled inside then just off the rail, came out into the second turn, swung three deep into the stretch and bested the others.

TWIRLING CANDY pulled between horses to stalk the pace, went up four wide then bid between foes on the second turn and into the stretch, bumped hard twice between between the top pair and steadied nearing midstretch and weakened. FIRST DUDE angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn, fell back some leaving that turn and also weakened. TWEEBSTER chased off the inside then outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SPURRIER saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. AGGIE ENGINEER angled in and dueled between horses, fought back into the second turn, fell back some leaving that turn and weakened. GLADDING pulled his way along inside and was in a bit tight passing the wire the first time, stalked along the rail then a bit off the fence, came out into the stretch and also weakened. PODE IR (BRZ) settled off the rail then outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident nearing midstretch but made no change when they ruled TWIRLING CANDY was responsible for the bumping.
