A supplemental nomination fee of \$12,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to entry. All starters will receive a \$3,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Any filly that competes in both the TVG Coaching Club American Oaks and the TVG Alabama will have their entry fee waived for the Alabama. 121 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, August 4, 2012 with 23 Nominations. (Clear 75)

QUESTING (GB) bumped with IN LINGERIE at the start, went to the front, raced a bit off the rail on the first turn, set a clear pace through very fast fractions for the distance, glided along on the far turn while her pursuers were all under a drive, was asked outside the quarter-pole, turned into the stretch with a sizeable advantage, swerved out while drawing off inside the three-sixteenths pole, ducked about while increasing the margin, raced under a right-handed whip into the final sixteenth then was hand ridden to the wire an impressive winner. IN LINGERIE bumped with QUESTING at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace while on the outside, came under urging with a half-mile to run, chased four then three wide on the far turn and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. VIA VILLAGGIO was bumped soundly in the hindquarters entering the first turn, raced mostly three wide on that turn, settled well off the pace, came under urging with five furlongs to run, was hard ridden while three then four wide on the far turn, came under the whip outside the quarter-pole and was best of the rest. ZO IMPRESSIVE was forwardly placed on the inside, came under a ride with a half-mile to run, chased inside on the far turn and tired then was unsaddled on the far turn and vanned off. GRACE HALL tracked the pacesetter while off the inside, came under urging outside the half-mile pole, chased between rivals on the far turn, came under the whip outside the five-sixteenths pole and faded. SEA ISLAND was bumped in the hindquarters entering the first turn, saved ground on that bend, lagged near the back, failed to respond when asked and faltered. UPTOWN BERTIE was taken in hand while behind rivals in the initial straightaway, bumped with rivals on both sides entering the first turn then steadied, lingered at the back of the field and also faltered.
