LADY OF FIFTY was hustled to a quick lead then settled nicely and rated very well from off the rail, responded once in the stretch to easily turn back SWEET NOTHINGS and pulled clear while being kept to her task. SWEET NOTHINGS broke alertly then took back just off the winner and tracked her into the stretch, eased outside that rival at the three sixteenths but could make no serious impact. RUN THE BLUES AWAY raced unhurried to the second turn from the two path, improved her position into the stretch but lacked the needed response. LA CHISPA settled early from the three path and within easy striking distance, had a brief menacing bid from the four path on the second turn but flattened out in the drive. DISTANT IMAGE prompted the winner from the outside for six furlongs and weakened. YOUR SPECIAL DAY was never a serious threat.
