Final nomination for Louisiana Derby closes Satur day, March 17, 2011, by subscription of \$1,000. \$5,000 to pass the entry box; \$5,000 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$50,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$1,000,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight: Colts and Geldings, 122 lbs.; Fillies, 117 lbs. Preference will be given in the following manner: First preference to graded or group winners in order (I,II,III), then highest career earnings (non-restricted), then total career earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box at usual time of closing. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A T ROPHY. HERO OF ORDER went two to three wide on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, took the lead midway through the far turn, inched clear outside the quarter-pole, responded well when put to the whip in upper stretch and was fully extended to last under strong urging. MARK VALESKI went four then five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong and gained gradually but missed. ROUSING SERMON went three wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and finished well to get the show. CIGAR STREET bumped with a rival at the start, raced three then four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed, chased three wide on the far turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick and just missed the show. SHARED PROPERTY was bumped on both sides at the start, settled while off the rail, was roused on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and also lacked the needed kick. WINDSURFER settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn, came off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed response. AFFORD went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and also lacked the needed response. Z DAGER raced five then six wide on the first turn, dropped in early on the backstretch, settled off the pace, raced inside early on the far turn then came off the rail, dropped back to the inside in upper stretch and failed to rally. FIRE ALARM settled off the pace, shifted four wide midway through the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and also failed to rally. FINNEGANS WAKE was reserved towards the rear, went three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. FLASHY SUNRISE lingered well back in the field, went four wide on the far turn and was no factor. MR. BOWLING saved ground on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to respond. COMISKY'S HUMOR set the pace through quick fractions, lost the lead midway through the far turn and stopped.
