Free nomination by Saturday, January 7th. \$400 to enter; \$400 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second, 10% to third. 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to sixth through ninth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 since November 21st, allowed 2 lbs. \$25,000 since October 21st, allowed 4 lbs, \$20,000 since then allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High Weights will be preferred. Different owners have equal draw according to weights. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY. Closed Saturday, January 7, 2012, with 23 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track a t 5 and 1/2 Furlongs.). INSPIRED quickly sprinted clear from the outside post, drew off while three wide on the turn, was asked for more in upper stretch and maintained a safe advantage under steady urging. WILD ABOUT MARIE was away alertly, dropped back while urged along, raced towards the inside on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. FLASH MASH was urged along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and finished willingly for the show. MULLINS BEACH was ridden along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed response. WELL DESERVED was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed response. DR. DIAMONDS PRIZE chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and tired. BORN INDY U S A was ridden along near the back, raced four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. SEEKING MS SHELLEY was void of speed, saved ground on the turn and showed little. GRAN LIONESS was ridden along on the outside, bumped into the injured RAPPORT early on the turn then clipped heels and nearly unseated the rider, moved to the extreme outside and was eased but walked off. RAPPORT chased the pace on the outside then broke down near the three-eighths pole. (Rail at 0 Feet)
