By subscription of \$300 each to accompany the nomination (Early Bird) on or before Thursday, December 22, 2011. Closed with 139. Early Bird nominees to the Santa Anita Derby are automatically eligible to, the Sham Stakes (Grade III), the Robert B. Lewis Stakes (Grade II), and the San Felipe Stakes (Grade II) with nomination and starting fees waived to those stakes. Regular nominations close Saturday, March 24, 2012 by payment of \$3,500 each. Closed with 3. All horses shall pay \$1,250 to enter and \$10,000 to start, with \$750,000 guaranteed, of which \$450,000 to first, \$150,000 to second, \$90,000 to third, \$45,000 to fourth and \$15,000 to fifth. 122 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. (Clear 82)

I'LL HAVE ANOTHER stalked between horses or outside a rival, came out in upper stretch, bid three wide in midstretch, battled three across the track through the final furlong and gamely prevailed under urging. CREATIVE CAUSE was in a good position stalking the pace inside then a bit off the rail, moved up along the fence leaving the second turn, angled out in upper stretch, bid between horses in midstretch, fought back between foes through the drive and continued willingly to the wire. BLUESKIESNRAINBOWS had speed four wide then kicked away and angled in, set the pace along the rail, fought back inside the top pair through the final furlong and also went on gamely to the end. PAYNTER bobbed at the start, settled outside a rival then chased between foes on the backstretch and second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and bested the others. BROTHER FRANCIS broke a bit slowly, angled in and pulled his way along between horses chasing the pace, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LIAISON chased off the rail then inside on the backstretch and second turn, was in tight off heels in midstretch, came out for room and could not offer the necessary response. MIDNIGHT TRANSFER four wide into the first turn, settled three deep chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and six wide into the stretch and did not rally. SENOR RAIN bobbed at the start, stalked three deep, came five wide into the stretch and weakened. LONGVIEW DRIVE between foes early, angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, came a bit off the rail on the second turn, was between horses a quarter mile out, drifted inward in midstretch and also weakened.
