1 1/2 MILES. (1.463) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *BEN ALI S. (GRADE III) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$7,500 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$750 to enter and an additional \$750 to start, with \$150,000 guaranteed, of which \$90,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes over a mile since October 27, allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade III stakes over a mile or two races over a mile other than maiden, claiming or starter since October 5, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Ben Ali will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings in 2012-2013. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. Closed Wednesday, April 3, 2013 with 35 nominations. (Clear 54)

SUCCESSFUL DAN opened clear and set a dawdling pace off of the inside, was shaken up to meet the bid of BOISTEROUS inside the three-sixteenths pole, and held sway under a well measured ride. BOISTEROUS was reserved four wide, moved up in earnest through the second turn, was within reach with a furlong to run but failed to make headway through the drive. RICHARD'S KID settled off of the inside, got through entering the stretch but failed to menace the top two. SON OF A GENERAL was nearest the pace three wide, but faltered between horses leaving the second turn and faded. HATTAASH was unhurried at the tail of the field, drifted out entering the stretch and lacked a response when called upon. STEPHANOATSEE lobbed along three wide, offered a mild bid between horses, but came up empty entering the stretch and retreated.
