Weight, 122 lbs. \$20,000 to pre-enter, \$20,000 to enter, with guaranteed \$2 million purse including travel awards of which 55% to the owner of the winner, 18% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth; plus travel awards to starters not based in California. SHE'S A TIGER advanced four wide outside rivals to go clear after a quarter mile, dropped in bit and set the pace under a light hold, extended her advantage leaving the far turn while under some nudging, met the bid of RIA ANTONIA near the sixteenth marker, drifted out despite right handed rousing brushing with that one about forty yards out, straightened away soon after and dug in tenaciously to narrowly prevail. RIA ANTONIA, taken to rate off the rail, commenced a her run leaving the five eighths pole, steadily progressed four wide into the lane to take aim on the leader, ranged up to challenge with about a sixteenth to go, was brushed dueling in deep stretch and just missed. ROSALIND came away awkwardly, dropped well off the early pace, angled out leaving the far turn, came three wide for the drive and finished well to be gaining inside the top pair. SWEET REASON, unhurried early, made a sharp rail run mid way on the final turn, angled three wide into the lane, lugged in past the three sixteenths marker and failed to seriously sustain her run in the final sixteenth. ARTEMIS AGROTERA moved off the inside around the first turn and chased the pace, dropped to the rail around the final turn, steadied off the heels of SWEET REASON in upper stretch and gave way. SCANDALOUS ACT, urged from the gate, chased four wide past the five eighths pole, faltered around the far turn then was eased in the lane. DESIGNER LEGS saved ground off the pace, checked to avoid the fallen horse leaving the far turn, angled out then back in and was eased in the drive. UNTAPABLE, five wide early pursuing the leader, began a retreat after a half mile, checked to avoid the spill then was eased. CONCAVE, three wide early, angled in, was taken up sharply to avoid SECRET COMPASS then was protected in the final quarter mile. SECRET COMPASS rated back from between horses into the first turn, angled in past the three quarter pole to give chase, edged closer near the half mile pole then broke down and fell approaching the five sixteenths marker. She was then vanned off and euthanized. Following a stewards' inquiry, SHE'S A TIGER was disqualified and placed second for causing interference in deep stretch.
