1 1/2 MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.45<sup>3</sup>) STAKES. Purse \$600,000 *DIANA S. (GRADE 1) INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD.* No nomination fee. \$6,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$12,000 will be accepted at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$3,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 twice on the turf in 2012-13, or a Grade 2 twice on the turf in 2013 allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade 1 in 2012-13 or a Grade 2 in 2013, 5 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 13, 2013 with 28 Nominations. (Clear 81)

LAUGHING (IRE) broke out a bit at the start, easily went to the front then was taken in hand, was well rated while setting a moderate pace along the rail, came under some pressure from CENTRE COURT nearing the five-eighths pole, continued on the pace while inside that rival, was the first of those two to be asked at the quarter-pole, responded well when put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch, disposed of CENTRE COURT into the final furlong, was quickly challenged by DREAM PEACE, fought gamely with that opponent to the wire and narrowly prevailed under continued right-hand urging. DREAM PEACE (IRE) settled on the inside, moved closer leaving the backstretch, drafted behind the leading duo on the far turn, was asked just after turning into the stretch, eased off the fence then chased under a drive, loomed alongside the winner near the sixteenth-pole but couldn't get by while finishing strongly to the wire. STEPHANIE'S KITTEN dropped back at the start, settled at the rear while off the inside, was taken out from behind cover in the vicinity of the half-mile pole, came under urging while four wide on the far turn, shifted in a tad after turning into the stretch, was put to a right-handed whip, remained at the rear into the final furlong, gained ground into the final sixteenth, switched to a left-handed whip late and finished with good energy but was belatedly on the scene while clear for the show. SAMITAR (GB) broke out a bit at the start, settled on the outside, moved closer leaving the backstretch, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick. CENTRE COURT was rated under a snug hold while on the outside, moved up early on the backstretch, drew alongside the leader, contested the pace on the outside from that point, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled under a right-handed whip into the final furlong then weakened. (Rail at 9 Feet)
