Chestnut Filly, (Apr), by Giant's Causeway - Bit of Whimsy by Distorted Humor. Trainer Tagg Barclay. Bred by Bonner Young(KY). NELLIE CASHMAN was a bit washy, came away in good order, saved ground on the first turn, dropped back early on the backstretch as the field began to spread out, settled nicely in third position, moved up with a half-mile to run, drafted behind the pacesetter while inside on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, eased off the inside then chased under a left-handed whip, drifted out a couple of paths near the furlong marker, was switched to a right-handed whip, took a straight course while pursuing the leader into the final sixteenth, gained the lead shortly thereafter, drifted out under a right-handed whip late and just held under strong urging. CAROLINE THOMAS went three wide early on the first turn then tucked into the two path, was reserved on the outside, came under urging leaving the backstretch, went three wide while urged along on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside under a right-handed whip, closed strongly into the final sixteenth, was carried out some late and just missed. WATSDACHANCES (IRE) tossed her head while rank behind horses nearing the wire the first time, raced between rivals into the first turn, was reserved while off the inside, came under urging leaving the backstretch, was ridden along while off the rail on the far turn, tipped three wide into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip, rallied into the final furlong, switched to a left-handed whip near the sixteenth-pole, gained fast on the winner, was carried out late then crowded between horses and just missed. CONCISE (GB) was taken in hand early, raced inside while under restraint on the first turn, dropped back early on the backstretch, was reserved towards the rear, moved out with a half-mile to run, was roused while off the rail on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch, came under the whip while in the center of the course and finished with good energy. TAPICAT went to the front, raced inside on the first turn, was well rated while setting the pace, controlled the action while inside on the far turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, cut the corner into the stretch, was asked for her best, led into the final sixteenth but was swallowed up late. SILSITA was well placed behind the pacesetter while off the rail, chased on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. BROKEN SPELL went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and tired. Following a stewards' inquiry and objection by the jockey of WATSDACHANCES, NELLIE CASHMAN was disqualified from first and placed third for interference in deep stretch. (Rail at 18 Feet)
