1 MILE. (1.33) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 *LONGACRES MILE H. (GRADE III) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARDS.* By subscription of \$250 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,500 to enter, \$1,500 additional to start with \$200,000 guaranteed. The host association's guaranteed moneys to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 15% to third, 7.5% to fourth and 2.5% to fifth. High weights preferred. In the event more than 12 horses are entered at closing time of entries, the 12 highest weighted horses entered will be preferred in the draw for post positions 1 thru 12. Field size will be limited to 12 starters with no also eligibles. (Cloudy 78)

HERBIE D broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear margin into the lane and held sway to the wire. STRYKER PHD was off a step slow, began to advance from off the rail through the second turn, angled out nearing the quarter and finished with good energy to be up for the place. GOLDEN ITIZ was void of early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and finished with a late rally. JEBRICA lacked early speed, angled out nearing the five-sixteenths pole, reached a contending position in mid-stretch but failed to gain late. GLADDING chased the winner from the outside throughout, was no match for that rival and gave way in the drive. WHY NOT BE PERFECT showed no early speed, clipped heels nearing the five-sixteenths pole, moved inside soon after and finished with good late speed. UNTIL YOU raced off the pacesetters from between foes and failed to rally. TRES BORRACHOS raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the second turn and was not a factor. POLITICALLYCORRECT raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and gradually weakened. WINNING MACHINE was away alertly to chase the winner from the outside and weakened after going three-quarters. MR. BOWLING was off a step slow then hustled along to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after going six furlongs. HOIST chased the leaders from the inside for a half and gradually weakened. The rider of WHY NOT PERFECT lodged an objection against GOLDEN ITIZ and STRYKER PHD concerning the clipping heels and steadying of her mount at the five-sixteenths pole and after reviewing the films the stewards made no change.
