1½ MILES. (Turf) (1.454) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 *QUEEN ELIZABETH II CHALLENGE CUP S. (GRADE I) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD.* By invitation with no nomination or starting fee, with \$400,000 guaranteed of which \$240,000 to the owner of the winner, \$80,000 to second, \$40,000 to third, \$20,000 to fourth, \$12,000 to fifth and \$8,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 121 lbs. The Keeneland Association will invite a representative field of twelve fillies to compete. The field will be drawn by the usual time of closing. A Keeneland trophy cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. A silver julep cup will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at One Mile and One-Eighth on the main track. (Clear 75)

**KITTEN'S DUMPLINGS** outrun early four wide while unhurried, advanced four wide on the second turn, angled out for the drive and closed well to be up late. **ALTERITE (FR)** within striking distance in the four path, moved in a bit on the backstretch, was asked to pick up her pace with three furlongs to go, maintained her position to the stretch then closed well late between rivals. **CAROLINE THOMAS** outrun three wide while on her own courage, lagged for six furlongs, launched her rally leaving the second turn and finished fast. **LEIGH COURT** sprinted clear in the run to the first turn, set the pace while kept out in the four path, moved in two paths on the second turn, drew off when asked in upper stretch but faltered late. **SAY (IRE)** within striking distance off the inside, moved out a path with three furlongs to go, angled out for the drive and rallied willingly. **I'M ALREADY SEXY** closest to the pace four wide, could not keep pace with the leader into the stretch then lacked a late bid. **EMOTIONAL KITTEN** outrun three wide, rallied the field to the stretch, came widest for the drive but was too late. **SARACH** forwardly placed along the inside, tired. **CONCISE (GB)** within reach while off the rail, saved ground on the second turn and stopped.
