WINDING WAY stalked the winner along the inside, came out into the stretch and was clearly second best. SWEET MARINI broke out but alertly, stalked off the rail, angled in a bit for the turn, lacked the needed response in the stretch but held third between foes late. SUGARINTHEMORNING chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch, angled to the inside in midstretch and was edged for the show. CURVY CAT settled off the pace away from the rail, angled in some on the turn, came out in upper stretch and was edged for third three deep on the line.
