ADMIRAL KITTEN, reserved in the opening stages while being guided nearer to the inside, continued between foes off the second flight racing to the backstretch, was urged to advance splitting foes racing into the second bend commencing a steady advance, swung out four wide nearing upper stretch and continued with a solid closing response to wrest command and kick clear under firm handling. STORMY LEN, forwardly placed tracking the pacesetter three deep racing to the backstretch, moved to challenge for command in that path racing through the far turn, moved clear while shifting to the inside racing into upper stretch but proved only second best when confronted by the winner. JACK MILTON, caught five wide in the run through the straight into the first turn, while being prompted to gain a position in the second flight, continued three deep into the second bend while making steady progress to bid between the top pair racing into upper stretch but was outkicked. DRAW TWO, reserved along the inside to the far turn, shifted off the rail entering upper stretch and continued to make steady progress between foes just off the inside to the end. VISIYANI (FR) tracked the pacesetter inside rivals in the opening stages, shifted off the inside on the backstretch to race between foes in the second flight, was urged through close quarters to lodge a brief bid between foes racing through the far turn but lacked the needed final response. AMEN KITTEN settled out of striking distance a bit off the inside racing to the far turn, saved ground on the second bend and made some belated progress between foes near the inside late. BALTHAZAR, caught four wide between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, couldn't produce the the needed closing bid. FIRST CORNERSTONE (IRE) angled inwards in the opening stages to track off the second flight, shifted out three deep on the backstretch, came under pressure to advance racing into the far turn but lacked a further response. TATTENHAM angled inwards early to track between foes just off the second flight, pulled his way to contention between foes in close quarters racing through the backstretch, was shuffled a bit avoiding a tiring foe racing through the far turn and had no further response. YEAGER, worked his way to the inside early tracking off the second flight, made brief progress inside foes racing through the backstretch, checked out of tight quarters nearing the second bend and steadily faded racing into the lane. RYDILLUC, forwardly placed attending a rival's pace in the opening half, pressed the issue briefly between foes racing into the second bend and gave way nearing upper stretch. GOLDEN JASON was urged to the lead along the inside from the break, disputed the issue for six furlongs and emptied out entering the far turn. BETHEL was guided to the inside early while setting in the last flight and never gained contention.
