By subscription of \$200 each on or before February 22, 2014 or \$1,000 each on or before March 26, 2014. A Supplementary Nomination of \$37,500 each may be made at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$3,750 to enter and an additional \$3,750 to start, with \$750,000 guaranteed, of which \$450,000 to the owner of the winner, \$150,000 to second, \$75,000 to third, \$37,500 to fourth, \$22,500 to fifth and \$15,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2014 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. The maximum number of starters for the Toyota Blue Grasswi II be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings. Starters to be named thru the rough the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. A silver julep cup will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, February 22, 2014 with 196 nominations. (Clear 69)

DANCE WITH FATE settled between rivals, waited in hand to the second turn, shifted out six wide to be clear, quickened once uncovered, made a sweeping move into the lane, forged command with a furlong to run and edged clear. MEDAL COUNT was allowed to settle, came six wide, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. PABLO DEL MONTE was away in good order to dictate terms, battled on through a long drive, was headed nearing the furlong marker, gave way but stayed on to safely preserve the show spot. BIG BAZINGA broke a step slow, tucked in to save ground, tipped out and advanced between rivals on the second turn, angled out entering the stretch and continued on willingly. COLTIMUS PRIME was unhurried along the inside, angled out leaving the second turn and improved position through the lane. GALA AWARD was allowed to settle, came eight wide to make a late rally but failed to seriously threaten. SO LONESOME broke slow, was unhurried into stride, swung to the far outside entering the stretch and finished with a belated gain. ASSERTING BEAR settled off of the inside, came four wide but went evenly through the drive. CASIGUAPU was forwardly placed between horses four wide to the stretch and flattened. COASTLINE chased four wide through the second turn, but weakened between horses and retreated. EXTRASEXYHIPZSTER was close up along the inside, got through entering the stretch but came up empty in the drive and dropped out. BOBBY'S KITTEN tracked the pace three wide between horses through the second turn and tired. HARRY'S HOLIDAY contended between horses for six furlongs and stopped. VINCEREMOS was close up five wide for three-quarters of mile then gave way readily.
