Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Jan), by First Defence - Rising Tornado by Storm Cat. Trainer Mott I. William. Bred by Millsec, LTD.(KY). CLOSE HATCHES came away in good order, went three wide early on the first turn, moved to a clear lead midway through that bend then dropped to one off the rail, glided over the muddy surface while cutting out solid fractions, controlled the action on the far turn, extended the advantage coming to the quarter-pole, responded well when asked in upper stretch, was placed under a strong hand ride while drawing off at the furlong marker, continued under a brisk hand ride until inside the sixteenth-pole then was eased up late while much the best in a dominant performance. FIFTYSHADESOFHAY broke in and bumped with a rival, raced in the two path on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along passing the half-mile pole, saved ground while ridden along on the far turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and safely secured the place. STANWYCK settled on the inside, was urged along while continuing to save ground on the far turn, came off the rail at the quarter-pole, moved out under a drive in upper stretch and was best of the rest. ANTIPATHY came off the rail midway through the first turn, tracked the pace, chased between horses on the far turn, turned into the stretch under the whip, continued between horses into the final furlong and tired. PRINCESS OF SYLMAR was unsettled in the gate, went five wide on the first turn, moved closer early on the backstretch, settled on the outside while not too far back, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, chased under a right-handed whip into upper stretch and came up empty. BELLE GALLANTEY went four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along outside the half-mile pole, raced in the two path on the far turn and faltered. MAJESTIC RIVER was bumped at the start, went three wide on the first turn, raced in the front half of the field, dropped back outside the half-mile pole, went three wide on the final turn and stopped.
