1 1/2 MILES. (1.452) STAKES. Purse \$1,000,000 SANTA ANITA DERBY (GRADE I) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$300 each to accompany the nomination (EARLY BIRD) on or before December, 28, 2013. Closed with 116. Early Bird nominees to the Santa Anita Derby are automatically eligible to, the Sham Stakes (Grade III), the Robert B. Lewis Stakes (Grade II), and the San Felipe Stakes (Grade II) with nomination and starting fees waived to those stakes. Regular nominations close Saturday, March 22, 2014 by payment of \$2,500 each. Closed with 3. All horses shall pay \$5,000 to enter and \$10,000 to start, with \$1,000,000 guaranteed. The winner to receive \$600,000 PLUS 100 KENTUCKY DERBY POINTS, \$200,000 to second, \$120,000 to third, \$60,000 to fourth and \$20,000 to fifth. 122 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (Clear 75)

CALIFORNIA CHROME a bit slow into stride and slightly crowded early, pulled between horses to duel for the lead, continued outside a rival on the second turn, took command nearing the quarter pole, kicked clear, widened while being ridden along in midstretch and proved best under a long hold late. HOPPERTUNITY chased a bit off the rail, waited some leaving the second turn, came out three deep into the stretch and was clearly second best. CANDY BOY a bit crowded early, tugged his way between foes then pressed the pace three deep, stalked on the second turn, came out into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive and just held third. DUBLIN UP sped to the early lead outside and angled in, dueled inside, came out into the stretch and weakened but was edged for third. BIG TIRE chased outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch and second turn, angled in some into the stretch and lacked a rally. RPRETTYBOYFLOYD broke a bit slowly, came off the rail then chased outside a rival and briefly between foes on the backstretch and could not offer the necessary response. FRIENDSWITH K MILL saved ground chasing the pace throughout and lacked the needed late kick. SCHOOLOFHARDROCKS pulled his way along four wide to press the pace into the first turn then stalked outside, dropped back on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened, then was not persevered with late.
