1 1/8 MILE. (1:44) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 Fair Grounds Oaks FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$400 by Saturday, March 14. \$2,000 to enter, \$2,000 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$10,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$400,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight 122 lbs. Preference will be given in the following manner: First preference to graded or group winners in order (I,II,III), then highest career earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Fair Grounds Oaks will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 14, 2015, with 19 nominations. (Clear 70)

I'M A CHATTERBOX raced in the three path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, took the lead midway through the far turn, inched clear at the five-sixteenths pole, responded well when set down in upper stretch and maintained a safe advantage under a right-handed whip. SHOOK UP raced in the four path on the first turn, settled on the outside, was asked while three wide on the far turn, chased the winner under a drive in the stretch and was second best. FOREVER UNBRIDLED raced in the two path on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, came under urging while in the two path on the far turn, chased into upper stretch and weakened. DANETTE broke about two to three lengths slow, raced in the two path on the first turn, lagged at the rear, was urged along on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. AUDREY'S DOUBLE had a shoe repaired in the paddock, raced in the two path on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along passing the five-eighths pole, went around the far turn in the two path while hard ridden and failed to threaten. TACHIELLO was taken back early, went three wide on the first turn, settled last but one, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and was no factor. DESERT VALLEY saved ground on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, was urged along while inside on the far turn and failed to respond. JUGNI went to the front, set the pace through solid fractions, lost the lead passing the three-eighths pole, dropped out at the five-sixteenths and faded.
