DA HOSS checked slightly while being bumped on the first turn, settled in the middle of the pack for five furlongs, edged closer while four wide on the turn, surged to the front in midstretch, dug in when headed a sixteenth out and prevailed in a stiff drive. HAWKSLEY HILL was outrun early after breaking a bit slowly, trailed for a half, split horses while rapidly gaining at the quarter pole, drew along side the winner to challenge in midstretch, gained a slim lead with a sixteenth remaining then yielded grudgingly. LABEEB was unhurried for five furlongs, closed the gap on the turn, circled five wide entering the stretch and finished willingly for a share. MAGELLAN raced far back for six furlongs then rallied belatedly. FLY TO THE STARS raced in close contention while between horses for a half, fell back slightly on the turn, remained a factor into upper stretch then weakened. SECOND EMPIRE steadied sharply between horses nearing the first turn moved up along the backstretch, raced within striking distance to the turn then lacked a strong closing bid. JOYEUX DANSEUR was reserved for a half rallied six wide on the turn and flattened out. FAVORITE TRICK alternated for the lead between horses into midstretch and tired. CAPE CROSS set or forced the pace while four wide into upper stretch and gave way. MR LIGHTFOOT failed to mount a serious rally. AMONG MEN battled along the rail to the turn and tired. MILITARY faded after a half. WAKY NAO steadied sharply in the early stages, never reached contention. DESERT PRINCE took up nearing the first turn, was finished after going five furlongs.
