Gray or Roan Horse, (Apr), by Holy Bull - Primal Force by Blushing Groom (FR). Trainer Orseno F. Joseph. Bred by Adena Springs(KY).

MACHO UNO, rated in behind the leaders early, commenced his bid inside front-running ARABIAN LIGHT nearing the stretch, fell back of that one and altered course to the outside, took over in the final furlong when soundly shaken up with the whip lefthanded, appeared to shy suddenly from an object in the infield approaching the wire, then lasted over POINT GIVEN. The latter, well in hand for six furlongs while saving ground, came out 10 wide to secure room when entering the stretch, closed fast but missed. STREET CRY (IRE), in behind horses while unhurried early, edged closer on the second turn, came out eight or nine wide for the stretch run, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but gained only slightly. BURNING ROMA, outrun until the stretch, edged up behind horses entering the stretch, swung out seven wide for the drive, altered course around FLAME THROWER in upper stretch, then could gain only slightly. ARABIAN LIGHT gained the lead soon after the start, maneuvered nicely to the inside, made the pace into deep stretch and weakened. TURNBERRY ISLE (IRE), outrun for six furlongs, improved position while eight wide in the stretch. CITY ZIP moved inside early, tracked the leaders within easy striking distance into the stretch but came up empty. FLAME THROWER went up early to press front-running ARABIAN LIGHT from the outside, held on well until the stretch and weakened gradually. SCORPION saved ground but tired. DOLLAR BILL failed to reach contention while also saving ground. NOVERRE attempted to drift out on the first turn, raced in contention in behind rivals for six furlongs and weakened. YONAGUSKA stalked the leaders five wide for six furlongs and tired. TRAILTHEFOX was outrun. A P VALENTINE gave way early on the second turn.
