Bay Gelding, (Mar), by Java Gold - Double Sunrise by Slew o' Gold. Trainer Headley Bruce. Bred by Carlos Perez(KY).

KONA GOLD, away in good order to stalk the leaders four wide, rallied from that position entering the stretch when called upon, caught front-running CALLER ONE in the final sixteenth, took over, then held HONEST LADY safe under steady handling in track record time.

HONEST LADY, outrun for a half, came out 10 wide entering the stretch and finished with good courage as second best. BET ON SUNSHINE, bumped soundly at the start and forced out on VALIANT HALORY, was angled inside, saved ground, rallied inside into the stretch, angled out a bit for the drive and finished with good energy. CALLER ONE gained the lead soon after the start, made the pace three wide, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage but faltered in the final sixteenth. MORE THAN READY, outsprinted early and saving ground, came out seven or eight wide in the upper stretch to secure room, bumped with DREAM SURPRISE about the eighth pole, then lacked a further response.

DREAM SUPREME, well placed early while following the leaders five or six wide, was bumped about the eighth pole by MORE THAN READY when that one came out and flattened out. SUCCESSFUL APPEAL, bumped at the start, raced within striking distance throughout but lacked a closing response. AGNES WORLD failed to rally after stumbling at the start. TRIPPI, close up inside from early on, was checked lightly about the half-mile ground, continued forwardly inside until the stretch and faded. DELAWARE TOWNSHIP, wide on the backstretch, failed to reach contention. ELABORATE, outrun until the stretch, failed to menace while nine or 10 wide in the stretch run. VALIANT HALORY, bumped at the start, was never close. SHADOW CASTER broke alertly to gain a brief lead, surrendered it to CALLER ONE, held on well for a half and gave way. FIVE STAR DAY ducked out at the start on BET ON SUNSHINE, tired early and wasn't persevered with when hopelessly beaten.
