1½ MILES. (Turf) (2.342) STAKES. Purse \$3,000,000 *JOHN DEERE BREEDERS' CUP TURF (GRADE J) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD*. Northern Hemisphere Three-Year-Olds, 121 lbs.; Older, 126 lbs.; Southern Hemisphere Three-Year-Olds, 116 lbs.; Older, 125 lbs. All Fillies and Mares allowed 3 lbs. \$30,000 to pre-enter, \$45,000 to enter, with guaranteed \$3 million purse including nominator awards (plus Net Supplementary fees, if any), of which 54% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5.1% to fourth and 2.5% to fifth; plus stallion nominator awards of 2.7% of all monies to the winner, 1% to second and 0.5% to third and foal nominator awards of 2.7% of all monies to the winner, 1% to second and 0.5% to third. Additional nominator awards to be paid from Breeders' Cup funds, not included in purse distribution. Stallion nominator awards of 0.255% of all monies to fourth and 0.125% to fifth and foal nominator awards of 0.255% of all monies to fourth and 0.125% to fifth. (Clear 70)

Chestnut Horse, (Apr), by Smart Strike - Belva by Theatrical (IRE). Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by Keene Ridge Farm (KY).

ENGLISH CHANNEL was hard held early along the inside, moved between horses along the backstretch, took charge leaving the far turn, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch then steadily increased his advantage under steady right hand encouragement. SHAMDINAN (FR) stalked the pace in the three path to the far turn, moved outside the winner to threaten midway on the turn but was no match for that rival while continuing on well to best the others. RED ROCKS (IRE) was taken well in hand early while saving ground, was rated just off the pace for a mile, angled between horses leaving the turn and finished evenly. BETTER TALK NOW raced far back for most of the way while saving ground, angled wide leaving the turn and failed to threaten while passing tiring rivals. DYLAN THOMAS (IRE) away slowly, saved ground early, raced between horses along the backstretch, angled out at the quarter pole and lacked a strong closing response. GRAND COUTURIER (GB) dropped back early and never reached contention while saving ground. FRI GUY set the pace in hand to the far turn and gave way. TRANSDUCTION GOLD stalked in the two path and gave way on the far turn.
