Gray or Roan Colt, (Apr), by Afleet Alex - Lucky Again by Wild Again. Trainer Reid, Jr. E. Robert. Bred by Roll Z Dice Racing Stable(KY).

AFLEET AGAIN , bumped at the break, settled back in the clear off of a contested early pace, exchanged sound bumps with GIANT OAK with about a half mile remaining, angled out six wide when rallying into the stretch, was forced out near the three sixteenths marker, was straightened away soon after, sustained his run under solid right handed encouragement, forged to the lead a sixteenth out then drew clear. BIRD RUN disputed the early pace inside PLEASANT PRINCE, eased back off that rival with seven furlongs to go, rated kindly just off the leaders into the far turn, shifted out nearing the stretch, challenged between rivals in mid stretch and stayed on well to earn the place. GIANT OAK was steadied off the heels of rivals when eager through the stretch the first time, bounced around with the winner near the half mile marker, angled five wide when making a run into the stretch, was brushed and forced out in upper stretch, battled between rivals when on near even terms a furlong out then hung late. PLEASANT PRINCE set a pressured early pace off the inside, was joined by BARYSHNIKOV seven eighths out, dueled, lost command near the five eighths pole, battled back along the rail to go clear with three furlongs remaining, could not go with CEASE leaving the five sixteenths pole and faded in the final furlong. CEASE rated just behind the leaders past the stands the first time, eased out and took aim three wide near the half mile marker, surged clear approaching the quarter pole, drifted out when fully extended in mid stretch then weakened. ELDAAFER lost ground four wide while in range, came under a strong drive nearing the far turn, advanced between rivals in upper stretch, drifted out brushing GIANT OAK soon after and tired. BARYSHNIKOV stalked the early pace three to four wide, moved to challenge around the second turn, dueled to the far turn then faltered. BRIGANTIN lagged back and failed to respond. HARRISON'S CAVE (GB) , bumped at the break, advanced inside nearing the three quarter pole, was put to a strong drive leaving the five eighths pole and faltered. MEEZNAH broke a step slow, was sent up to contention inside rivals soon after, was scrubbed along under the wire the first time, failed to respond, faltered and was eased in the drive. A. U. MINER , away awkwardly, settled well back off the early pace then was pulled up in distress near the three furlong marker and vanned off.
