Bay Gelding, (Feb), by Successful Appeal - Lisa Danielle by Wolf Power (SAF). Trainer Lopresti Charles. Bred by Mort Fink(KY).

SUCCESSFUL DAN bumped with NATES MINESHAFT at the break then steadied back from between rivals soon after, settled back off the pace, saved ground into the far turn, angled out with three furlongs remaining, gained four wide while within himself approaching the stretch, responded when put to stout left handed pressure a furlong out, closed determinedly to wear down FORT LARNED then edged clear at the wire. FORT LARNED disputed the early pace between rivals then was rated back near the seven furlong marker, prompted the pace in hand outside PLUTONIUM, moved to command while still in hand three furlongs out, spurred clear after six furlongs, turned away a challenge from MUCHO MACHO MAN entering the lane, held a clear advantage past the furlong pole, battled gamely but just could not withstand the winner's charge. MUCHO MACHO MAN, taken in hand and angled out around the first turn, stalked the pace three wide, moved to loom a solid presence near the quarter pole, failed to sustain his bid when put to a drive and faded the final eighth. GOLDEN YANK, brushed at the break, lagged well back off the pace, angled six to seven wide for the drive and had some belated action. APART, a bit washy, broke inward making contact with GOLDEN YANK, dropped back early, saved ground nearing the quarter pole and failed to respond. NATES MINESHAFT, bumped with the winner leaving the gate, vied inside rivals then was rated back approaching the backstretch, stalked towards the rail into the far turn, came under pressure leaving the three eighths pole, gave futile chase to the quarter pole then weakened. COLIZEO broke outward, recovered to gain a stalking position, was asked for run two to three wide leaving the far turn and dropped back. PLUTONIUM vied three wide early then went clear, dropped in to set the pace, was overtaken with three eighths to go then faltered.
