GAME ON DUDE had speed inside then stalked a bit off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter into the second turn, put a head in front nearing the stretch, inched clear and proved best under a left handed tap of the whip and steady handling. NONIOS stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive and was second best. RICHARD'S KID unhurried and angled in through the stretch the first time, saved ground off the pace, split rivals into the stretch, came out nearing midstretch and just got the show. RAIL TRIP angled in and stalked outside a rival, came out into the stretch and weakened. SUGGESTIVE BOY (ARG) in tight between foes early, chased outside a rival or off the rail to the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WINNING MACHINE had speed outside the winner then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. EMPIRE WAY settled outside a rival chasing the pace, came three wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. GROOVIN' SOLO in tight off heels early, angled in and saved ground to the stretch and weakened. BALLADRY three deep into the first turn, chased outside, dropped back off the rail on the second turn and gave way.
