1¹/₂ MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.573) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 *BOWLING GREEN S. (GRADE II) INNER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD*. No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination payment of \$4,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the publication of weights. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Dirt weights, Three Year Olds 119 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstake at a mile or over on the dirt in 11-12 allowed 2 lbs.; \$40,000 at a mile or over on the dirt in 2012 allowed 4 lbs.; four races on the dirt, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, dirt allowance weights will apply and it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. AIR SUPPORT secured the pocket in the opening stages, was under a snug hold before being switched over to the mildest of coaxing to maintain interest while proceeding down the backstretch, continued along on the same scenario until the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was cued up and angled outward, settled into upper stretch and set out after BOMBAGUIA, found little success during the initial portion of the stretch drive, but ate up the deficit more readily from the furlong marker to the sixteenth pole, was directly alongside at that juncture, wore down what proved to be a very stubborn opponent in the last few strides to prove best. BOMBAGUIA came out of the starting gate with no apparent mishap and quickly established control, had NEWSDAD latch on leaving the first turn, was accompanied by that rival until just past the half mile pole, with nearly a lane of separation between the two front runners, edged away from the field during the run around the far turn, remained under rating tactics until the head of the stretch, held his ground well during the ensuing furlong, but felt the winner's presence soon afterwards, showed gameness to the end, but got reeled in prior to the wire. BRILLIANT SPEED swung three wide into the backstretch, was hand urged while overhauling a tiring NEWSDAD then, taken inward once safely by, this occurring near the five-sixteenths pole, proved no match when called upon. BRUJO DE OLLEROS (BRZ) raced along the outside and tired. NEWSDAD off to a sluggish beginning, made a three wide run under his own power to take up the role of stalker, kept pace with the runner up, placed at a considerable distance from off the rail, fell back despite being asked for some run at the top portion of the second turn and steadily tired.
