Chestnut Filly, (Apr), by Bowman's Band - Deputy Doll by Silver Deputy. Trainer Bradley William. Bred by Fred Bradley & William Bradley(KY).

GROUPIE DOLL, ridden along from the start, raced six wide in range past the five eighths pole, dropped in to about the four path and leveled off under strong urging mid turn, quickly gained into the stretch, forged clear of DUST AND DIAMONDS in mid stretch and pulled away under strong left handed encouragement. DUST AND DIAMONDS prompted the pace three wide, moved to command into the stretch, briefly cleared in upper stretch, was displaced by the winner approaching the furlong grounds, kept on willingly and was clearly best of the rest. SWITCH, allowed to drop well off the early pace while removed from the rail, swung out six wide for the drive and had some belated interest. BELLE OF THE HALL saved ground off the pace, slipped through inside into the lane, shifted out past the eighth pole and had a mild response. RUMOR, urged along off the rail, angled five wide into the stretch but failed to menace. MUSICAL ROMANCE, forwardly placed five wide and between runners the opening quarter, was eased back and angled down near the half mile pole, rushed up nearing the turn, chased in about the two path into the lane, worked outward in the final eighth but came up empty. TURBULENT DESCENT, four wide between foes chasing the early pace, gave way after five furlongs. TEDDY'S PROMISE was sent up inside and established command exiting the chute, set a strong pace in the two path, met the challenge of DUST AND DIAMONDS approaching the quarter pole, gave little resistance and faltered. GREAT HOT (BRZ), shuffled back early, angled in nearing the turn and then back out three wide near the three eighths pole, gave chase to the quarter pole then tired. STRIKE THE MOON, hustled up between rivals early, chased four wide around the turn and gave way in upper stretch.
