SHANGHAI BOBBY broke outward and bumped with MONUMENT, was straightened and moved up three wide to attend the pace, moved to command under a rating hold with three furlongs remaining, kicked clear when asked, widened approaching the stretch, met the bid of HE'S HAD ENOUGH approaching the eighth pole, regained focus under solid right handed pressure, dug in resiliently and narrowly proved best. HE'S HAD ENOUGH saved ground under rating, took closer order nearing the half mile marker, steadied along past the five sixteenths marker, shuffled back soon after, advanced along the rail in upper stretch, shifted out and ranged up outside the winner while drifting out, was straightened with the right stick, dueled gamely from there but just could not get past. CAPO BASTONE allowed to settle back off the pace while saving ground, angled out when gathering momentum mid way on the final turn, was maneuvered five wide between foes entering the lane and kept on with interest though no match for the top pair. FORTIFY drifted out bothering POWER BROKER nearing the first turn, was guided back in and moved up four wide to stalk the pace, made a threatening move in upper stretch but failed to sustain his bid in the final furlong. POWER BROKER, hustled from the gate, was carried out six wide into the first turn, continued well out into the strip giving chase, made a slight gain after a half mile, was floated out seven wide for the stretch run but could not recover. DYNAMIC SKY, taken to rate off the rail, advanced to forward position near the far turn, was herded out five wide making some progress into the stretch, steadied in tight quarters in mid stretch, altered in and came up empty. SPEAK LOGISTICS stalked the pace off the inside, chased between rivals leaving the far turn, raced in range into the stretch then faded. TITLE CONTENDER moved to a clear lead around the first turn, set a solid pace close to the rail, was overtaken departing the far turn, chased the winner to the quarter pole, began to tire soon after then steadied when engulfed in upper stretch. MONUMENT, bumped at the break, was under a ride three to four wide past the five eighths pole, failed to respond and gave way.
