Bay Gelding, (May), by Spanish Steps - Hay Jude by Wavering Monarch. Trainer Romans L. Dale. Bred by Carlo E. Vaccarezza(FL).

LITTLE MIKE angled in and stalked inside, bid between horses leaving the second turn to gain the lead nearing the stretch, kicked clear and held along the inside under urging. POINT OF ENTRY saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside into the stretch, came a bit off the rail in deep stretch and surged outside the winner on the line. ST NICHOLAS ABBEY (IRE) chased outside a rival, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished with interest. TRAILBLAZER (JPN) stalked outside a rival or off the rail, made a bold bid four wide leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch but was outkicked in the final furlong. SHARETA (IRE) settled outside a rival chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished with some interest. KINDERGARDEN KID unhurried and angled in a bit off the rail early, trailed just off the inside, swung out into the stretch brushed with a foe in upper stretch and improved position. COGITO squeezed a bit at the start, settled inside, saved ground, split horses leaving the second turn, swung three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SLIM SHADEY (GB) angled in and pulled his way along a bit off the rail stalking the pace, came out leaving the second turn and three wide into the stretch and weakened. DULLAHAN three deep on the hill, settled outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch, brushed with a foe in upper stretch and did not rally. TREASURE BEACH (GB) was in a good position stalking the pace inside to the stretch, steadied in tight in upper stretch and weakened. OPTIMIZER close up stalking the pace outside a rival then off the rail, bid three wide between foes leaving the second turn and also weakened. TURBO COMPRESSOR sent inside to the early lead, set the pace along the rail then off the fence on the backstretch, angled back in on the second turn, dueled briefly leaving that turn and had little left for the stretch. Rail on hill at zero.
