**7 FURLONGS. (1.202) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 CHURCHILL DOWNS S. (GRADE II) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.** By subscription of \$300 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$20,000 each at the time of entry. \$2,000 to pass the entry box; \$2,000 additional to start, with \$400,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes since November 4 allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade I or II stakes since September 5, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Churchill Downs will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest 2011-2012 earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations are required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, April 11, 2012 with 32 nominations. (Cloudy 78)

**Chestnut Colt, (Feb), by Forestry - Oatsee by Unbridled. Trainer Romans L. Dale. Bred by Mike Lauffer & Bill Cubbedge(KY).** SHACKLEFORD pressed the early pace inside, eased back after a quarter and angled out, was sent between rivals into the turn to challenge, battled the runner up into the stretch then edged off late while urged with both the whip and the rider's right hand. AMAZOMBIE vied for the lead three wide, went with the winner after a half, battled that one to the final sixteenth and held on to be second best while not able to stay with the winner late. GANTRY outbroke his rider, recovered to be close up four wide, stayed on well to the stretch and tired. ALMA D'ORO outrun for a half along the inside, came off the rail for the drive and improved his position while no threat. SMILING TIGER bobbed after the start, angled out while in hand, raced in the five path into the stretch and could not threaten. APRIORITY reserved three wide, could not threaten. HAMAZING DESTINY hopped a bit at the start, raced within striking distance three wide and faded. WILL'S WILDCAT with the pace off the rail, moved to the inside entering the turn, held on well to the stretch and gave way.
