STAY THIRSTY unhurried while staking the front runners along the outside, was let out at notch and proceeded to be placed in the four path a short distance prior to the quarter pole, turned for home and was set down, closed in well, hooked up with the runner up past the eighth pole, was battling on even terms when brushed lightly by that opponent, continued on with true grit and got the job done at the finish line.

GROUPIE DOLL sat patiently perched three wide just off the front runners, crept up to draw alongside them leaving the midway point on the turn, was the widest of three spinning into the stretch, got set down to a vigorous drive, both with the whip and being hand ridden, gained a narrow lead at the end of the furlong grounds, bobbed and weaved ever so slightly while making her way towards the wire, was in the midst of doing so when she brushed late with the top one, dug in gamely to the end, but got denied. COIL latched on to BUFFUM soon after the start, disputed the pace with that foe while racing along the outside, with the rider holding something back in reserve, was forced to contest for the lead from between rivals once the runner up made her presence more pronounced during the later stages of run around the bend, went on a little further before being asked for run, kept up the dispute until deep stretch, backed away slightly, but continued finished willingly nonetheless to earn the show. BUFFUM came away with no apparent mishap, argued with COIL for command while saving ground, had the runner up make it a three way battle coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was the first of the three to have the rider commit to encouragement, cutting the corner under a drive with only the threesome only heads apart with each other at this juncture, remained in the fight until a short distance past the eighth pole and gave way. HYMN BOOK under solid urging coming three wide into the stretch, was always outrun.
