(GRADE 1) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$300 each or by supplementary nomination of \$20,000 each by 12:00 noon (EST) Thursday, November 15, 2012. \$2,000 to pass the entry box; \$2,000 additional to start, with \$400,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Friday, November 16, 2012. The maximum number of starters for the Clark Handicap will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to highweights, with consideration to the scale of weights for age. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, November 7, 2012 with 30 nominations. (Clear 49)

Chestnut Colt, (Feb), by Forestry - Oatsee by Unbridled. Trainer Romans L. Dale. Bred by Mike Lauffer & Bill Cubbedge(KY). SHACKLEFORD sprinted clear, set the early pace near the three path, stayed out three wide on the second turn while setting moderate fractions, increased his lead in midstretch when asked for his best then lasted late while drifting out in the closing yards. TAKE CHARGE INDY reserved while prompting the winner, raced four wide around the second turn while patiently handled, could not quite keep pace with the winner in midstretch, then when coming again late, was bumped and carried out by BOURBON COURAGE when that one was carried out by SHACKLEFORD. BOURBON COURAGE reserved along the inside, moved up three wide after six furlongs, angled out a bit for the drive, began to cut into the winners lead in midstretch, moved out a bit when carried out by that one in deep stretch, bumped TAKE CHARGE INDY then held gamely. LUNAR VICTORY within striking distance three wide, made a good middle move off the rail but tired once in the stretch. MISSION IMPAZIBLE prominent outside, raced five wide around the second bend and gave way in the drive. CEASE reserved off the inside, raced in the three path on the second turn and was no threat. STEALCASE outrun three wide, moved in a path on the second turn and could not menace. FAST FALCON trailed for six furlongs raced four wide on the second turn and was and was no factor. EYE OF THE LEOPARD close up along the inside, gave way.
