STEPHANIE'S KITTEN bumped with RUN A RISK approaching the first turn in traffic and in tight while defending her position, moved closest to the pace off the inside on the second turn, slowly reeled in the leader approaching the furlong marker and drew clear under steady urging. FIREHOUSE RED reserved along the inside the opening half, continued to save ground on the second turn, angled out entering the stretch and closed well late to be up for the place. WELCOME DANCE vied for the lead off the inside, took over before a half, led the field to the final furlong and weakened. TREASURED UP outrun three wide, angled out five wide late on the second turn when rallying but could only pass tiring rivals. DAME MARIE took back a bit and angled in to the three path entering the first turn, moved out a bit and made a good four wide middle move but could not sustain the bid. KOKO LOCA (IRE) outrun three wide, rallied belatedly. MIZ IDA close up four wide, moved in a bit on the backstretch, continued prominent while in the three path on the second turn but tired in the drive. LILY HANNAH outrun along the inside, was no threat. RUN A RISK eager early while restrained, bumped with the winner approaching the first turn, steadied when in a tenuous position once in the first turn, recovered to race within striking distance while continuing a bit eager but gave way in the drive. JUNE CLEAVER forced the pace along the inside, held on well for six furlongs and tired. GOLDRUSH GIRL within reach early five wide, maintained a forward position to the final quarter and faded. MORE THAN LOVE in close along the inside into the first turn, raced within striking distance for six furlongs and faded.
