1 MILE. (Inner Turf) (1.33²) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 *FOURSTARDAVE H. (GRADE II) INNER TURF A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* No nomination fee. \$5,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$10,000 will be accepted at any time prior to the publication of weights. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$2,500 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. **DIRT Weights:** Three year olds, 121 lbs.; Older 126 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the dirt in 2011-12 allowed 2 lbs.; A sweepstake on the dirt in 2011-12, 4 lbs.; four races on the dirt, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track where dirt allowance weights will apply. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stake s Committee. Closed Saturday, July 28, 2012 with 35 Nominations. (Cloudy 78)

WISE DAN struck the left side of the starting gate after lunging at the start, went on to secure the pocket, contently tracked the pacesetter, lightly hand urged to maintain interest, continued along on the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, was forced to remain on hold, awaiting suitable options commencing from the quarter pole, idled behind the leader, lacking optimal racing clearance, but keeping well within striking distance, had that rival drift out ever so slightly nearing the eighth pole, wasted no time availing of the opportunity, shooting through the newly-created opening, took over a couple of jumps later, then drew off impressively, crossing the wire under a hand ride. CORPORATE JUNGLE settled into midpack from off the inside, remained unhurried under a good hold, found room to angle outward in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole once UPGRADE fell back at that juncture, eventually taking the four path for entrance into the lane, came inward a bit while advancing towards the front runners while arriving at the furlong marker, taking SURFRIDER along for a short ride in the process, loomed boldly, failed to keep pace with the winner, but continued onward willingly to garner the place. GET STORMY was hand urged from the starting gate, poked a head in front nearing the end of the homestretch and had the rider switch over to rating tactics, showed the way under the watchful eye of SURFRIDER parked one path further off the rail, turned for home at a slight distance off the rail and with several others in close pursuit, reached the furlong marker now two wide, providing just enough space for the top one to launch his move, got overhauled shortly afterwards and steadily weakened. GUYS REWARD slow to settle into stride, was sluggish in the early going, began to pick up the pace upon reaching the backstretch and steadily closed the gap, came three wide into the stretch, continued to advance for an additional furlong before flattening out. UPGRADE swung three wide into the backstretch, remained out there for the run around the far turn, began falling back steadily coming to the five-sixteenths pole. YIELD BOGEY was placed into the three path departing the opening bend, ranged up to press the issue as the widest of three around the far turn, kept up that pursuit until upper stretch, tired. SURFRIDER (IRE) forwardly placed right from the start, patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, did so from between rivals on the second turn, appeared to be backing away, when carried inward slightly by the second place finisher in mid lane, was momentarily taken in hand, tried to get going again, but had little left to offer.
