DREAMING OF JULIA came away in good order, sat patiently parked just off MY HAPPY FACE's hind quarters while proceeding down the backstretch, latched on to increase her presence coming to the half mile pole, gap-dueled with the previously mentioned rival, with neither being asked for a significant response, poked a head in front turning for home and got asked for more run, raced with hardly anything separating her from the chief nemesis as the pair made their way through the furlong grounds, having drifted inward ever so slightly during the tussle, came inward slightly once more past the eighth pole, traded light bumps with MY HAPPY FACE, herself stubbornly holding her position now, was carried out slightly in the late stages, yet gamely prevailed, crossing the wire being flashed the whip from the right side. MY HAPPY FACE quickly established control after the start and settled near the inside, was under a firm hold in the initial stages, during which the winner was keeping a watchful eye, had that rival draw alongside just before reaching the half mile pole, raced as a team around the turn, fell back a sliver by the end of it, entered the stretch and was called upon, battled with vigor but couldn't reclaim the advantage during the ensuing furlong, exchanged a series of light bumps with the top one, mostly once past the eighth pole, refused to yield her lane in deep stretch, came out slightly in the final seventy yards and had to settle for being second best at the conclusion of a fine effort. TOASTING got away last after making contact with the left side of the starting gate, chased the front runners towards the two path, was set down in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and momentarily made up some ground, flattened out. NANCY O (IRE) three wide departing the half mile pole, failed to respond when asked for run at that station, turned for home under a protective hold and got eased.
