Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Jan), by Vindication - Majestically by Gone West. Trainer Asmussen M. Steven. Bred by Padua Stables(KY).

DUST AND DIAMONDS away from the starting gate with no apparent mishap, took up the role of stalker soon after the start, did so with the rider atop with a firm hold on the reins until the end of the backstretch, was put to some light coaxing after entering the turn and began to close in on **ROMAN TREASURE**, latching up after going a half, continued to cut into the lead and spun into the lane on nearly terms with the aforementioned opponent, shook free under a strong drive during the ensuing furlong, drifted out a couple of lanes in the late stages, but remained clear, kept to strong handling to the finish line. **JUDY THE BEAUTY** got bumped at the start, sat within striking distance from off the inside, angled outward leaving the the five-sixteenths pole, settling to be three wide by the three-sixteenths pole, finished willingly under a hard drive but had to settle for place honors. **MUSICAL ROMANCE** tracked the front runners while taking the inside route on the turn, was taken outward in upper stretch, mustered up a mild response to grab the show. **TURBULENT DESCENT** chased the front runners from the two path during the run around the bend, swung outward for the stretch drive, got beaten to the three path coming to the three-sixteenths pole and had to tip outward slightly more, remained in contention until midstretch before flattening out. **ROMAN TREASURE** made contact with **ISLAND BOUND** leaving the starting gate, cleared the field quickly under her own power, felt the presence of the top one soon after departing the backstretch, got put to a stern test by the opponent entering the stretch, succumbed shortly afterwards and tired. **EMMA'S ENCORE** bobbed awkwardly at the break prior to being bumped by **C C'S PAL**, was guided into the two path soon afterwards, fought against the bit proceeding most of the way down the backstretch, was more relaxed after entering the turn but was still pulling slightly, commenced the stretch drive from the five path, lacked the needed closing punch. **C C'S PAL** bumped by the runner up at the start, bounced off that rival and into **EMMA'S ENCORE**, was hustled along while darting over to the inside, rode the rail around the turn while put to constant urging, tired. **ISLAND BOUND** bumped lightly with **ROMAN TREASURE** at the start, brought up the rear of the pack while saving ground, fanned five wide into the stretch with no offering to render.
