**ALWAYS KITTEN** outrun in the early going, advanced four wide through the second turn, challenged just inside the furlong marker, strong handling, edged clear. **FLEET DAWN** void of speed, five wide rally out of the final turn, finished willingly to annex the place. **COURTNEY'S HOPE** allowed pace to go, in the second flight into the far turn, three wide through that bend, challenged inside the furlong marker, not enough late, broke down under wire. **PROMISE ME MORE** last away, trailed early, three wide when roused out of the final turn, rallied through traffic, bothered under the wire when **COURTNEY'S HOPE** broke down. **GOOD NIGHT** raced in mid pack off the inside, between foes into the far turn, in traffic late in that bend, went evenly when clear for the drive. **LONNIE BELL** raced back, in traffic far turn, between foes into the lane, raced in tight quarters briefly a furlong out, improved late. **MY DAUGHTER'S SONG** broke on top, got clear into the first turn, dueled second turn, continued to show the way past the furlong marker then fell apart late. **MISTY SWAMP** chased the leader closest to the inside, had little left for the drive. **WILHELMINA** allowed to settle, shuffled back far turn, failed to recover in the drive. **SHEILA TEQUILA** finished early, wide, outrun. **SAPPHIRE BREEZE** closest to the leader backstretch, dueled through the final turn, stopped in the drive.
