Gray or Roan Colt, (Mar), by Master Command - Unbridled Betty by Unbridled's Song. Trainer Bush M. Thomas. Bred by Sequel Thoroughbreds LLC & A. Lakin & Sons Inc.(NY).

UNBRIDLED COMMAND came out when in tight off heels leaving the first turn, chased outside, advanced three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, gained the advantage, kicked clear under urging and held. GRANDEUR (IRE) unhurried and angled in to save ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and six wide into the stretch and finished well. LUCKY CHAPPY (IRE) also settled well off the pace inside then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and closed willingly. RJWA (IRE) chased between horses or off the rail, continued between foes on the second turn, steadied in tight nearing the stretch, came out for the drive and was outfinished. POWER FOOT settled off the pace outside then three deep, went four wide on the second turn, was fanned out five wide into the stretch and was outfinished. SUMMER FRONT allowed to settle outside rivals chasing the pace, continued three deep into and on the second turn, steadied when forced four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MY BEST BROTHER angled in with speed outside a rival to duel for the lead, inched away and angled to the inside in the run to the first turn, set the pace along the rail, battled inside the winner into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. ALL SQUARED AWAY chased outside, went between horses on the second turn, was forced out four wide in tight nearing the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. BIG BANE THEORY saved ground stalking the pace, steadied in tight and came out nearing the stretch and weakened. HANDSOME MIKE had speed between foes then a bit off the rail, stalked between horses on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch. GOLDEN TICKET angled in and duelled inside then saved ground stalking the pace to the stretch and also weakened. SMART ELLIS unhurried along the inside, was in tight off heels leaving the first turn, came out on the second turn, steadied in traffic leaving that turn and was fanned five wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. GENERAL LOGAN stalked outside then three deep, steadied in traffic past the quarter pole and was forced four wide into the stretch and also weakened. SPEAKING OF WHICH (IRE) close up stalking the pace between horses, took up sharply in very tight off heels past the quarter pole, angled in and dropped back.
