**1 MILE. (Turf) (1.313) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 LONGINES JUST A GAME S. (GRADE 1) FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$5,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$10,000 in addition to the entry fee may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters including supplements to receive a \$2,000 rebate. The purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Weights Three-year-olds, 116 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 twice in 2011-12 or a Grade 2 twice on the turf in 2012 allowed 3 lbs.; A Grade 1 in 2011-12 or a Grade 2 in 2012, 5 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted races not considered in allowances). Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, May 26, 2012 with 23 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the main track.). (Clear 78)**

TAPITSFLY was lightly urged to grab the early lead, set splits from the rail, well rated and facing only mild resistance from the closest pursuer, remained under the same conditions throughout virtually all of the run around the bend, edged away from the competition leaving the five-sixteenths pole, most of whom were already being asked for some run from their pilots at this juncture, was a few strides into the stretch run before being asked for some run herself, arrived at the eighth pole still holding a comfortable advantage and with the runner up on the outside in full flight bearing down hard, successfully staved off the challenger to prove best, kept to a drive to the end. WINTER MEMORIES three wide proceeding down the elbow chute, remained well off the rail thereafter, got let out a notch getting placed into four path at the midway point on the full turn, closed the gap approaching the quarter pole, was given her cue and took off in earnest after settling into upper stretch, made a little more progress from upper to midstretch, but none once past the eighth pole, dug in with good determination to preserve the place. HUNGRY ISLAND rode the rail in the opening stages, was guided into the two path shortly before reaching the end of the backstretch, was asked for run coming four wide into upper stretch, rallied to grab the show award. UP IN TIME (GB) tucked along the rail early, continued along the inside route for nearly six furlongs, was kept on hold, briefly awaiting suitable options nearing the quarter pole, entered the stretch and was quickly taken outward, displayed a mild kick to earn the final major check. SYLVESTRIS (IRE) rode the rail, made an abbreviated bid prior to cutting the corner into the lane before backing away. WALLIS (GB) fought against the bit nearly from the get-go while undertaking the role of stalker, attended the pacesetter from the outside, barely latched on for the opening three-quarters pole, tired steadily after entering the stretch. DANCINGINHERDREAMS underwent a three wide journey, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths marker, tired.
