Bay Colt, (Apr), by War Front - Database by Known Fact. Trainer McGaughey III R. Claude. Bred by Stuart S. Janney, III LLC(KY). DATA LINK was unhurried and tucked in to save ground, took closer order through the second turn, wheeled out entering the stretch, joined the vanguard five wide and wore down TURALLURE in the final yards. TURALLURE settled in hand three deep, came four wide to make a bold bid, wrestled control from the determined GET STORMY inside the furlong marker, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. DOUBLES PARTNER settled saving ground, shifted out to commence his advance on the second turn, was bottled up between horses into the stretch, steadied when GET STORMY drifted out with a furlong to run, angled to the inside and finished well but was left with too much to do. GET STORMY sent clear to set the pace off of the inside, widened into the stretch, but drifted about in the drive and grudgingly gave in. HOLLINGER tracked three wide in hand, but faltered between horses entering the stretch and faded. PRESSDAY (AUS) pulled to contention along the inside, but came up empty after six furlongs and retreated.
