Closed by subscription of \$400 each on or before Friday, August 10, 2012 which should accompany the nomination with 40 nominations. (No sustaining payments) Late nominations, for horses not previously nominated, may be made on or before Friday, October 5, 2012 by payment of \$2,000, which should accompany the nomination. Closed with 5. Late nominations, for horses not previously nominated, may be made on or before Thursday, November 15, 2012 by payment of \$5,000, which should accompany the nomination, of which \$4,000 is refundable if the nominee is entered and does not draw into the body of the race or if the nominee is not entered and a veterinarian certificate is produced indicating the horse is unfit to run. BETTER LUCKY stalked inside then steadied and was forced out leaving the first turn, tracked a bit off the rail then outside a rival leaving the second turn, bid alongside the pacesetter to gain the lead past the eighth pole, kicked clear under urging and held. TIZ FLIRTATIOUS saved ground early, was forced out leaving the first turn, angled in and chased inside, moved up along the rail into the stretch, came out past midstretch and finished well. SUMMER SOIREE had good early speed outside then alongside a rival, inched away and angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, opened up on the backstretch, fought back inside the winner in midstretch, could not match the top pair late but held third. FUTURE GENERATION (IRE) pulled her way along outside a rival then stalked inside on the backstretch and second turn, came off the rail in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. DAYATTHESPA pulled along the inside stalking the pace, jumped shadows, propped and came out nearly losing the rider leaving the first turn, stalked inside on the backstretch and second turn, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and could not offer the necessary response. EMULOUS (GB) broke slowly, settled outside a rival, was forced out into the backstretch, chased alongside a foe then between horses on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. STAR BILLING also forced out leaving the first turn, chased outside a rival then three deep on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. VAMO A GALUPIAR (CHI) unhurried off the rail early, trailed throughout and was not a factor. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident on the first turn before ruling DAYATTHESPA was the cause of her own trouble.
