DREAMING OF JULIA sat entrenched in the two path, raced as a team with FULLY LIVING parked one path to her outside before putting her way for what proved to be for good soon after entering the turn, doing so under light coaxing, left the three-eighths pole with all but AMETHYST having already been set down to strong drives, drew off comfortably just before reaching the next station and was asked for a bit more, won with authority, hand urged although not briskly so. FULLY LIVING three wide, chased the winner, failed to keep pace despite being put to a drive slightly more than halfway around the bend. OVER THE COUNTER off the inside, ducked over to the rail after going past COLORFUL IMAGE at about the midway point on the turn, cut the corner having already been put to strong handling well before reaching it, went on to best the rest. AMETHYST underwent a three wide pursuit and folded. COLORFUL IMAGE roused at the three-eighths pole, faded off a ground-saving journey.
