MORNING LINE was hard to manage during the warm up, had speed outside a rival then angled in and set the pace inside, inched away again on the second turn, kicked clear in the stretch and held on gamely under left handed urging. PRAYER FOR RELIEF also showed good early speed then stalked inside, came out for room in midstretch and finished willingly alongside the winner. KETTLE CORN fractious in the gate and away awkwardly, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace throughout and picked up the show. THIRTYFIRSTSTREET chased outside a rival then between horses on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. HONOUR THE DEPUTY three deep into the first turn, settled outside a rival then off the rail, angled to the inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch, angled out onto foes and was bumped in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. GLADDING three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, bid outside the winner on the backstretch, tracked that one alongside a foe on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. JAYCITO off slowly, pulled his way along inside then came out on the first turn, tugged between horses on the backstretch and second turn, came out into the stretch, was bumped and steadied in midstretch and did not rally. AWESOME GEM chased outside a rival then three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response in the drive. GREAT WARRIOR (BRZ) a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival, went three deep on the backstretch and second turn, came out into the stretch, was bumped and forced out some in midstretch and also lacked a rally. Following a stewards' inquiry, HONOUR THE DEPUTY was disqualified and placed ninth for interference in midstretch.
